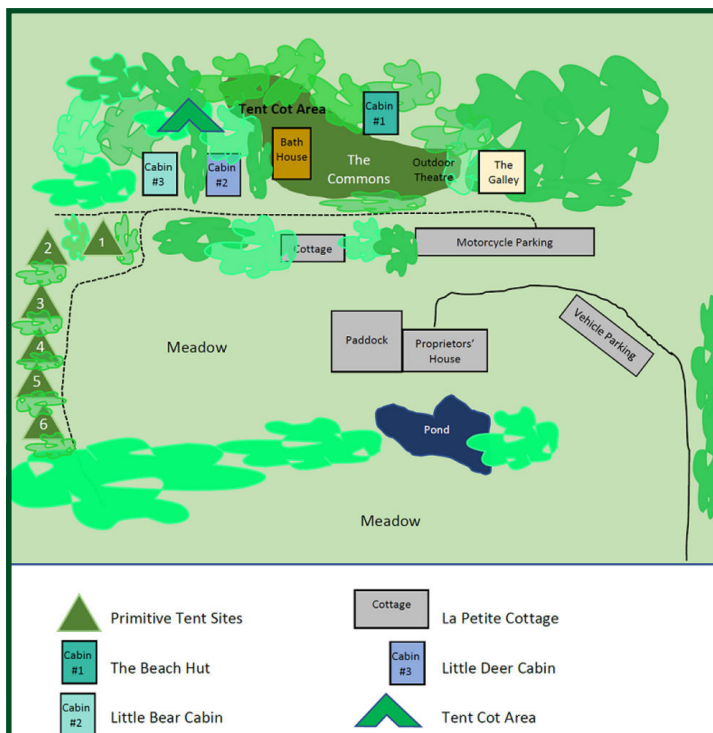

Go 1.3 miles, turn left into driveway (there will be orange bumpers on the mailbox on the right side of the road). Follow driveway (5 mph speed) to fork, bear left at split. Parking along driveway.
